My services are currently analysing the stakeholders' responses to the CSDR targeted consultation and, as you know, remain in regular contact with them. At this point in time, no decision has been made on the changes that may be proposed as part of the Commission proposal to amend CSDR. Moreover, I would like to underline that the Commission will only be able to determine the concrete amendments to present for adoption by the co-legislators after my services have conducted a thorough impact assessment according to the Better Regulation Guidelines.

My services are of course at your disposal, should you wish to provide us with further information, in addition to that included in your responses to the targeted consultation, to support your views.
