



Cook Islands response to COVID-19 Timeline


● Swabs taken daily ● Flu Vaccine administered daily



The Cook Islands Emergency Response Plan to Coronavirus Disease 2019




Stages	Code	Phase
Initial Action Stage	Blue	Preparation and Readiness (Delay entry of disease)
Targeted Action Stage	Yellow	Alert (Delay wide disease transmission)
	Red	Activation (Mitigate impact of the disease)
Stand-down stage	Green	Post-event (Recovery)






Swabs taken and Flu Vaccine administered in the last month




