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SCIP Notification (IUCLID)

- ECHA uses IUCLID files format (i6z) to receive all kinds of legislative data information.
- IUCLID is the International Uniform Chemical Information Database maintained by ECHA and the OECD. ECHA's mandate originates from REACH Article 111 ("Formats and software for submission of information to the Agency").
- The format is expressed in XML, and XML
 Schema definition files (.xsd)

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SCIP Notification (IUCLID)

- IUCLID format is updated once a year. The SCIP information requirements will be implemented as part of the upcoming IUCLID October release.
- IUCLID format, defines the IUCLID Dossier as the vehicle to notify the Articles within the SCIP context
- The IUCLID dossier, zipped in the i6z format is then uploaded to the ECHA Submission portal
 - Manually (Using IUCLID)
 - Via S2S (Preparing IUCLID dossier independently)


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

SCIP planned timeline

- Initial Q&A and public material ready from early September
- Dates from now to January 2021
 - IUCLID Format publication expected end October 2019
 - 1st IT User group WebEx Today
 - Workshop open to all (In ECHA, 1 day) 12 November 2019
 - Early Q1 2020 Prototype release
 - Deadline for MS to transpose legal requirements into local law 5 July 2020
 - SCIP submission version 1.0 release end of October 2020
 - Notification obligation starts for industry 5 January 2021



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
